Library Policies include, but are not limited to:

- Lost and damaged items will incur replacement costs.
- Please report any damage you notice before checking material out to avoid charges.
- Limit 20 items per card, five DVDs.
- One-week checkout for DVDs.
- Three-week checkout for books and audiobooks
- Three automatic renewals unless an item is on hold.
- Limit two eBooks at a time.
- Rules of Behavior and other policies are available at the front desk or by scanning the QR code on this brochure.
- Late fees are .15¢ per day for books and \$1.00 per day for DVDs.
- Children under 18 are late fine-free!
