- Township Contracts/Non-resident Fees
 - Resolution letter from Eric Williams in 2015 that dissolved the current township contracts and forgave any previously owed money from the townships.
 - Contract examples
 - Big Rapids Township will be putting a library millage on the ballot soon.
 - The City of Big Rapids calculated the average cost of a library card by evaluating the city patron usage numbers by household which equaled approximately \$120.
 - Ralph Crew motions that the Big Rapids Community Library Board offers the current serviced townships three options going forward: a township contract that requires a 2/10 of a millage plus penal fines and every resident of that township gets a residential library card; the township will pay \$125 for each resident who wishes to get a library card (based on the previous fiscal year's numbers; or an interested resident will pay by their

own \$100 non-resident fee for services. Chelsea Mitchell supported that we present these three options to the township boards (Barton, Big Rapids, Colfax, Grant, Green, and Norwich) before July 31, 2022. All members in favor. The motion was approved.
